I, Will that piece, parcel or lot of land in Glassy Mountain Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina having the following metes and bounds and courses and distances; Beginning on a stake in Vaughn's Creek, running thence North 29 degrees West 6.30 to a point on the branch, thence North 82 $\frac{1}{2}$ West 2.50 to a point on the branch, thence North 53 West 9.50 to a point on said branch, thence South 77 $\frac{1}{2}$ West 9.30 to a point on said branch, thence South 75 West 2.35 to a point in said branch, thence South 51 $\frac{1}{2}$ West 11.00 to a stake, thence South 62 $\frac{1}{2}$ East 13.66 ch. on a plat made by J. H.
