these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said W. H. Birmingham his heirs

and assigns forever:

All that lot piece or parcel of land, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, known and designated as Lot 70.67, of Plat 70.1 of the property of the Tryon Development Company, known as Lake Laniar, made up George Verstaw, L. E., and duly recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds for Greenville County, South Carolina.

Beginning at a point in the center line of Tryon Boulevard at a distance of 2,556.3 feet from its intersection with Tryon-Spartanburg Highway, said point being located exactly on the point of tangency or ending of a circular curve with a radius of 93.1 feet, said ending of curve being referenced by two concrete monuments as shown on the aforesaid plat, and running thence along the center line a distance of exactly 50.0 feet to the southward and eastward, thence northward along a line drawn perpendicular to said center line a distance of 157.6 feet more or less to center line of first street north of Tryon Boulevard a distance of about 55.5 feet to a point of intersection of said center line with a line drawn radial to said curve from the point of Beginning of this description a distance of 178.0 feet more or less to the point of Beginning, saving and excepting a strip of land adjacent to the center line of Tryon Boulevard bounded by a line to the 4.0th of, parallel to and 15.0 feet distant from the center line of said Tryon Boulevard, and a strip of land adjacent to the center line of the first street north of Tryon Boulevard bounded by a line to the south and west of, parallel to and 15.0 feet distant from center line of said street, which strips of land are reserved for the use by the public as streets and be it understood that all distances described as curved lines in this description are to be measured in chords of 30.0 feet or fractional parts and that the said lot has a width at the building line of 57.0 feet more being Lot 67 of the Holmes Hill Station of
