WHEREAS, I, the said Ennis Smith

Dollars, to be paid as follows: One hundred Dollars on or before Nov.

February 1st 1923, Fifty Dollars March 1st 1923, Fifty Dollars April
1st 1923 and Twenty five Dollars May 1st 1923

with interest thereon from at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

the amount due on said note to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part
thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage): as in and by the said note, reference

grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said J. N. Starling and Lula C. Starling

See that certain piece parcel or lot of land situate, lying
and being in the County and state aforesaid and
in what is known as East Overbrook. Beginning at
an iron pipe on the north east corner of Central
Street (Road) and Park Avenue (Road), thence along
Central Street N. 40. 0 E. 197 feet to an iron pipe,
thence along line of D. R. Stutler's property N. 23. 5 W.
33 feet to an iron pipe, thence along line of
J. N. Starling and Lula C. Starling S. 42. 16 W. 193. 7 feet
