SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, we, the said Jacobs Wilson and Eliza Wilson, in and by a certain W. S. Bradbury, even date with these presents, are well and truly indebted to W. S. Bradbury, in the full and just sum of one hundred two Dollars, to be paid ten years from this date.

with interest thereon from the eleventh of the month of January, 1922 at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum to be computed and paid quarterly.

.....until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal, and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid; then the whole amount evidenced by said note, to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten dollars,

.....besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That we, the said Jacobs Wilson and Eliza Wilson, in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said W. S. Bradbury,

according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to W. S. Bradbury, the said Jacobs Wilson and Eliza Wilson, in hand well and truly paid by the said W. S. Bradbury,

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said W. S. Bradbury, his heirs and assigns,

all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate in the state and County aforesaid, in Ward 2 of the City of Greenville, and being located as follows: the corner of Sumter and St. E. Hall Streets, in the year 1911 said corner being situated in Block 21 of Sumter and St. E. Hall Streets, and Block 21 containing 16 rods, 16 feet wide, 12 rods long, and having the following met and bounded: to the west: beginning at a stake on the corner of Sumter and St. E. Hall Streets, and running thence with Sumter Street b. 12-55 w. 30 feet to a stake, thence w. 74-30 e. 60 feet to a stake, thence n. 12-55 e. 30 feet to a stake, thence e. 74-30 n. 60 feet to the beginning corner and being the corner tract of land, and belonging to us, the said Jacobs Wilson and Eliza Wilson, in W. S. Bradbury, by virtue of this date, this mortgage is given to secure the payment of the balance of the purchase price and other expenses aforesaid lot of land.
