Skelton, Esq., in the full and just sum of Sixteen Thousand and One hundred Dollars (\$16,000.00) Dollars, to be paid at the date and place hereinabove mentioned, and interest thereon from January 1st, 1924, to January 1st, 1925, and thereafter until paid in full, at the rate of six per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid.

until paid in full, all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal, and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid; then the whole amount evidenced by said note, to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee.

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage): as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and reassign unto the said S. O. Skelton,

All that certain parcel and lot of land in the County of Greenville, aforesaid, on the south side of Court Street, in the city of Greenville; beginning at a point on the northeast corner of a 10-foot alley and Court Street, running thence with said street S. 71° 39' E. 30 feet to a point, corner of said 20-foot fence with line of said street S. 18° 21' W. 100 feet to an iron gate on the 10-foot alley thence with line of said alley 26'-7 1/2" by 28'-2" feet to a point at eastern fence of lot No. 1, thence with line of said lot N. 19° 00' E. 46 feet 1 inch to a point at the northeast corner of lot No. 1, thence with line of a road 10'-7 1/2" W. 6 feet 3 1/2 inches to the middle of a 10-foot alley; thence 22'-11 1/2" E. with middle of said alley 2'-3" and 11 inches to a point on east Court Street, then S. 71° 39' E. 5 feet to the beginning corner, being a point 20'-5" in shadow and a point made by H.
