may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

10% of amount due besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part
thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage): as in and by the said note, reference
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

and State aforesaid and known and designated as
lots No. 10 (ten) and 11 (eleven) in block "E" in plat of survey
of land of W. N. Norwood known as "Norwood Heights"
made by W. D. Neve, Surveyor and recorded in the of-
fice of the Register of Meane Conveyances for Greenville
County in Plat Book "E" pages 215 and 216. Said lots
having a front age on Vance Street of 25 feet and a
depth of one hundred and fifty feet, more or less,
to the land of the Woodside Mill Company.

Also all that other lot or lots of land, situate just
outside the corporate limits of the City of Greenville,
in the State and County aforesaid and known
and designated as lots Nos. eight (8) and nine (9) in
Block "E" in plat of survey of land on W. M. Norwood,
