 kind, reference being hereunto had will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, Mary A. Griffis, in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better
 securing the payment thereof according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me

in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and
 released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said James M. Beatty, Attorney all
 my right, title and interest in and to
 all that piece, parcel, tract or lot of land situated in Greenville,

Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

In the city of Greenville on the northwest corner of
 Pinckney and South Main Streets, having a frontage of
 105 feet on Pinckney Street with a depth on
South Main Street of 166.2 feet.

The above described lot of land is the same
 formerly owned by Mrs. Matilda A. Jennings and
 devised by her to John Jennings. The interest
 hereby conveyed is the undivided one-third
 interest which I inherited from my deceased
 husband, the said John Jennings.
