SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I, the said Luther Fisher
in and by my certain Promissory note in writing, of
even date with these presents, and well and truly indebted to

Warren Atkinson
in the full and just sum of Three Hundred and Thirty (300.00)
Dollars, to be paid One year after date

with interest thereon, from the date at the rate of eight per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid

and paid in full; interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

Twenty Five Dollars besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part
thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the said Luther Fisher for and
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said

according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said

in hand well and truly paid by the said Warren Atkinson

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do
grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Warren Atkinson

All that piece, parcel, or lot of land in the City of Greenville
County of Greenville and State aforesaid, on an alley which runs
in a southerly direction from Jenkins Street and having the
following metes and bounds: Beginning on the said alley at
the corner of a lot heretofore said by W. O. Sewell to miss
fifty feet; and running thence in a southerly direction
along the said alley, fifty feet to a stake; thence about
N. 68 E. one hundred and twelve feet, more or less to the right
of way of the Columbia Greenville R.R. right of way; thence
in a northeasterly direction along the said right of way
fifty feet, more or less to a stake on the line on the
said tract; thence along the line of the said lot,
about N. 68 W. one hundred and thirty six feet, more or less
to the beginning corner on said alley. The depth of this
lot is only given approximately, as it extends to the
right of way of the said railroad in the rear. This is the
same lot conveyed to me the said Luther Fisher by S. D.
W. 7133 by deed dated Feb. 10, 1921 and Recorded in R.M.C.
