until full with interest at 8% after maturity usually add 8% on all  
unpaid interest and interest becomes due until paid in full  
and due date of \$150.00 interest from date at 8% annually  
until paid, dated December 1st, 1923

with interest thereon, from 1921 at the rate of per cent per annum to be  
computed and paid.

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or  
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who  
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

\$100.00 besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to

thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind, (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said

Earleat and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do  
grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said J. M. Taylor his heirs and assigns

all that piece, parcel or lot of land situated, lying and -  
being in Greenville Township, County and State aforesaid -  
near the City of Greenville being a part of a subdivision  
known as City View according to a plat of same which  
is recorded in the office of R. M. C. for Greenville County  
in Plat Book No. 1, at pages 460 and 461 said lot being  
known and designated upon said plat as lot no. 13 in  
Block B, said lot has a frontage on the west side  
of R. M. C. Street of fifty (50) feet and runs back in  
parallell lines one hundred fifty (150) feet to a ten  
foot alley and being the same lot conveyed to me by  
B. M. Blagener by deed dated January 1st, 1923 to be -  
recorded.
