WHEREAS, *J. F. Ballenger*, of the County of Greenville
in and by *W. P. Ballenger, Committee* certain *Laurel Street* note in writing, of
even date with these presents, *January 1st 1924* well and truly indebted to.

W. P. Ballenger, Committee

in the full and just sum of *Five hundred (\$500.00)*

Dollars, to be paid *January 1st 1924*

with interest thereon, from *January 1st 1924* at the rate of *7* per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid *January 1st 1924*

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of.

Five percent besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part
thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said *W. P. Ballenger, Committee*

in hand well and truly paid by the said *W. P. Ballenger, Committee*

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do
grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said *W. P. Ballenger, Committee, his successors and*

assignees all that certain lot and parcel of land situate in the
State of South Carolina Greenville County, designated as
Block No 55 of plat No 2 of the property of the Parker
Land Company, surveyed by A. S. Redell Sept 1915 and
containing fifteen acres more or less and being the
same land conveyed to me by W. P. Ballenger by his
deed dated the 3rd day of January 1921 recd. recorded
in R. M. C. Office of Greenville County in vol. 48 at page
