even date with these presents, *John S. Sibley Ward*,
well and truly indebted to *W. H. Peacock, Attorney for Plaintiff*,

in the full and just sum of One hundred dollars (\$100.00)
Dollars, to be paid August 26th, 1873

John S. Sibley Ward
with interest thereon, from *August 26th, 1873* at the rate of *Eight* per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid *John S. Sibley Ward* until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, and note further providing for an attorney's fee of *One Dime (10¢)*

.....besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part
thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

said lots have the following
