party of the first part, and the MECHANICS PERPETUAL BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, of Greenville, S. C., a corporation, party of the second part,

WITNESSETH, Whereas, the said party of the first part is indebted to said MECHANICS PERPETUAL BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION in the sum of \$1,000 The sum of One Thousand Dollars, money loaned this day, with interest thereon from this date at the rate of eight

per cent. per annum, payable weekly, the payment whereof the said party of the first part is anxious to secure.

Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises and for further consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said party of the first part has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said party of the second

part all that certain acre, parcels of land within Greenville County, in the State aforesaid, as follows to-wit:

An East side lot on King Street, in Ward One, City of Greenville, and running full width of street and bounded beginning at a corner on King Street, corner of lot formerly owned by W. R. Woodward and running S. 54° E. 170 feet to stake, thence N. 55° 34' E. 60 feet to a stake, thence N. 36° 17' E. 170 feet to a stake on King Street, thence along King Street S. 55° 34' W. 60 feet to beginning corner containing 10,200 square feet more or less, and designated as lot 700, 8 on plat made by Dees, N. Dickson, D. A. and recorded in office of R. M. C. for State and County aforesaid in Vol. 77, page 164, being the same conveyed to Frances Speegle Boggs, etc., herein date of deed dated April 30, 1921, recorded in Book 90 page 580.
