THIS INDENTURE, made this 3rd day of January A. D. 1924
by and between P. O. Lawton

WITNESSETH, Whereas, the said party of the first part is indebted to said MECHANICS PERPETUAL BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION in the sum of Three Thousand five hundred

Dollars, money loaned this day, with interest thereon from this date at the rate of eight per cent. per annum, payable weekly,

the payment whereof the said party of the first part is anxious to secure:

Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises, and in further consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said party of the first part has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said party of the second part all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land lying in Greenville County, in the State aforesaid, as follows to-wit:

the Greenville Township in subdivision known as "Kanawha" and known as lot no. 18c 15 in revised plat of said property recorded in R. M. L. Office for said County and having a frontage of forty feet on Oregon Street, bounded, beginning at a stone pillar on the side of Oregon Street, 120 feet west of corner of Oregon and Fuller Streets, and running thence along Oregon Street N. 63° 35' E. 60 feet to corner at corner of Oregon and Fuller Streets, thence along said lot N. 63° 35' W. 60 feet to corner at corner lot 6; and ending at the corner of Oregon Street, being the same lot as last described and granted to P. O. Lawton by P. A. Lawton by deed dated 18th December 1923, record in Book 46 page 333.
