the payment whereof the said party of the first part is anxious to secure:

Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises, and in further consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said party of the first part has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said party of the second part all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land lying in Greenville County, in the State aforesaid, as follows to-wit:

 known and designated as lot no 17 of Block A
 according to a plat on record in the office of R. M. C.
 for Greenville County in Plat Book A, pages 396 and
 397 said being more fully described as follows:
 Beginning at a pin on Bridley street, joint
 corners with lots 17 and 18, and running thence
 along lines of lots 17 and 18 approximately 75 feet
 to a pin on 10 foot alley, thence with said alley in
 northerly course approximately 101 feet to a pin on
 Bridley street, thence with said Bridley street in a
 southerly course approximately 74 feet to the place
 of beginning being the same conveyed to G. L.
 Howard by A. E. Howard by deed dated March 30,
