in and by *my* certain Bond or Obligation of even date herewith stand firmly held and bound unto CITIZENS BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, of Greer, Greenville County, South Carolina, in the full sum of *Dollars One hundred* Dollars, conditioned for the payment of the monthly sum of *American five* Dollars, on the first Tuesday *fifth* of each and every month succeeding the date hereof, until each and every share in the said Association shall reach the value of ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS, and also for *ten percent* attorney's fees, in case of suit or of collection by or through an attorney, which, in addition to said debt, is hereby sealed and made a lien on the premises, as in and by the said Bond and Condition thereof, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

in hand, well and truly paid by the said Citizens Building and Loan Association, of Greer, Greenville County, South Carolina, at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said *G. Nash Bates*

have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Citizens Building and Loan Association, of Greer, Greenville County, South Carolina, all that lot of land, in said State and County, in the City of Greer, on the *First*

side of *Wall Street* Street.

Begun and running from an iron pier on James street, N.W. corner, and runs thence N. 7° 15' E. 152.5 feet to an iron pier, corner and back corner thence A. 82-15 E. 62 feet to an iron pier thence back to an iron pier on James street, thence S. 71.83° 30' N. 52 feet with James street to the beginning corner, and being known as a part of Lot #9 on a plat made by W. D. Nease, Esq. April 1922, and being the same lot of land conveyed to me by W. D. Nease where I now live.
