SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, *I*, the said *Maggie G. Black*,
in and by *1926* certain *December 1926*,
even date with these presents, *the sum of \$1500.00*,
A. P. Dardar, attorney
in the full and just sum of *Fifteen Hundred (\$1500.00)*
Dollars, to be paid *at the first present date*,

with interest thereon, from *date* at the rate of *Eight* per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid *semi-annually*,

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note..... to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of *ten percent*,

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
the amount due on said note....., to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part
thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note....., reference
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do
grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said *A. P. Dardar*, attorney

all that tract of land situate in the State and County
aforesaid about two miles southwest of the Town of Greenville
and on the south side of the Mountain Road and on
the Green Pelham Road (designated as Lot 720.6 according
to a survey made by H. A. Christopher September 1, 1922),
and having such metes and bounds as shown by said
plat and in deed from W. D. Smith to me dated October
11, 1922, recorded in Vol. 87, page 239, O. M. C. Records for
Greenville County, reference to said plat and deed being
had for a more complete description of said land.

The above tract contains *3 1/2* acres, more or less
