All that certain parcel or tract of land lying and being in Austin Township County and State aforesaid and having the following metes and bounds to wit; Beginning at stone on old line below Shoals or branch, thence down branch as line 31.50 to stake in mouth of small branch, thence up branch as line 8.25  $\frac{1}{2}$  E. 16.14 to stone, thence N. 72  $\frac{3}{4}$  E. 8.40 to stone, thence S. 72  $\frac{3}{4}$  E. 8.50 to pine stump and stone, thence N. 24  $\frac{1}{4}$  W. 17.85 to the beginning, containing 38 acres more or less, less 20 acres sold to John Smith.
