computed and paid semi-annually on the 1st day of August and 1st day of February, 1923  
until paid in full, all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or  
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who  
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of \$100.00

grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Woodville Investment Company

and being lot number nineteen (19) of the original Overbrook subdivision according to survey  
and plat of the Overbrook Land Company and being of record in the office of Register of  
Deeds Conveyance for Greenville County in Plat Book "E" at page 251; said lot having the  
following metes and bounds, to-wit:-  
beginning at a point on the western side of Walnut Street, said point being the joint corner  
of lot number nineteen (19) and lot number eighteen (18) and running thence N. 51-41 E. 45.1  
feet to an iron pipe; thence N. 41-07 E. 42.6 feet to an iron pipe on the western side of  
Walnut Street; thence N. 55-13 E. 221.1 feet to an iron pipe; thence S. 24-47 E. 61 feet to
