 Dollars, to be paid as follows: Eight hundred Dollars (\$800.00) the 13th of August 1924,
 Eight hundred dollars (\$800.00) the 13th of August 1925, Eight hundred dollars
 (\$800.00) the 13th of August 1926, Eight hundred dollars (\$800.00) the 13th of August
 1927, Eight hundred dollars (\$800.00) the 13th of August 1928.

with interest thereon, from date at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum to be
 computed and paid annually.

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
 interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who
 may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten per cent.

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to

 grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said B. J. Whiteaker, All that piece, parcel or lot of land,

situate, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid, just outside the City limits on
 the south side of Laurens Road, beginning at a stake at the southeast corner of Smith Avenue
 and Laurens Road, thence along the east side of said Avenue 100 feet, thence along the line of
 property of J. S. Farmer 100 feet to a stake; thence along the estate of T. G. Glenn 95 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet;
 thence along the south side of Laurens road 100 feet, this being the same property conveyed to
 me this day by the said J. S. Farmer, the deed to be recorded.
