And I her do hereby bind myself, my Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said mortgagee her Heirs and Assigns, from and against me, my Heirs, Executors, Administrators and Assigns and every person whomsoever lawfully claiming, or to claim, the same or any part thereof.

PROVIDED ALWAYS, NEVERTHELESS, and it is the true intent and meaning of the parties to these presents, that if I the said mortgagor, do and shall well and truly pay, or cause to be paid unto the said mortgagee the said debt or sum of money aforesaid, with interest thereon, if any shall be due, according to the true intent and meaning of the said note, then this deed of bargain and sale shall cease, determine, and utterly null and void; otherwise to remain in full force and virtue.

AND IT IS AGREED, by and between the said parties, that I the said mortgagor, am to hold and enjoy the said Premises until default of payment shall be made, in which event the mortgagee or his representative or assigns shall be entitled to take possession immediately, without notice, receive the rent and profits and apply them to said debt until the same is paid.
