 ceedings of any kind, reference being hereunto had will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I..... the said George Brownlee

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better  
 securing the payment thereof according to the terms of the said note..... and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me.....  
 in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold  
 and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Sallie A. Bathraas

all that piece of land situated in Gaith

Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

Maintainer miles from City of Greenville, on the Greenville  
 Bridge Road, on waters of Saluda River, adjoining lands  
 formerly of David Phillips, John Headless,  
 and others, said having the following corners and  
 boundaries, and distances: Beginning at a stone  
 340' on the Old Durham Bridge Road on the  
 south-east corner of a tract of one hundred ten  
 acres of land conveyed by Richard T. Watson to Martha  
 E. Calhoun October 2, 1847, and recorded in R.M.C.  
 Office for said County and State in Book L.S.P. page  
 453, and running thence S. 27 $\frac{1}{2}$  E. 12.00 chains to a  
 stake on the creek thence up said creek following
