ceedings of any kind, reference being hereunto had will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, that I, W. M. Keeler and Lina B. Keeler
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better
securing the payment thereof according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me
in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold
and released, and by these presents do give, bargain, sell and release unto the said J. R. Jenkinson
all that piece, parcel, tract or lot of land situated in
Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

THE DEBT HEREBY SECURED IS PAID IN FULL AND THE LIEN OF THIS INSTRUMENT IS SAID TO BE RELEASED, THIS 23rd DAY OF OCTOBER 1927 BY W. M. Keeler and Lina B. Keeler

About three miles west of the city of Greenville on the south side of the Parker Road, running from a point near Monaghan Mill to a point near Wainwright's store, containing 24.11 acres more or less and having the following metes and bounds: Beginning at an iron pin on the south side of Parker Road, at S. L. Huff's corner and running thence with line of S. L. Huff and J. P. Williams S. 55-55 W. 25.47 chains, more or less, to store in line of B. G. Huff, thence with his line S. 32-35 E. 7.51 chains to corner of triangle conveyed by S. P. Hair to O. V. Hunt, thence with his line S. 82 E. 3.40 chains, thence still with O. V. Hunt's line N. 55-55 E. 22.05 chains to store on south side of Parker Road, thence with Parker Road in a northwesterly direction 9.70 chains, more or less, to the beginning, being part of the same conveyed to S. L. Huff by J. S. Duman Master.
Also that other tract of land in Gates Township County and State aforesaid, containing 34 1/2 acres more or less being the same conveyed in two parcels to W. M. Keeler, one tract of 37 acres by Jerry C. Coleman by deed dated November 28th 1908 said recorded in book 333 page 348 and the other of 2 1/2 acres conveyed to W. M. Keeler by O. W.
