 Beginning at a rock on Reedy River, running thence 62 $\frac{1}{4}$ East 1085 to a stone, thence S. 61 $\frac{1}{4}$ West 78-16 to a stone, thence North 19 West 10 to a stone, thence South 63 $\frac{3}{4}$ West 9-20 to a rock on Reedy River, thence down said River to the beginning corner.
