Mary Gallamore as Committee for Eugene W. Gallamore, and Fanny C. Scott as Judge of Probate for Greenville County all that piece, parcel, tract or lot of land situated in Greenville

Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the Northern side of the Southern Railway Company, adjoining Farmer's Mill Hill, the J. P. Earle Estate and others, containing 16 acres, more or less described as follows:

Beginning at a stone 3xnm on the right of way of the Southern Railway 50 feet from the centre of the track, and running thence S. 26 $\frac{1}{4}$ E. 19.25 to a stone 3xnm; thence N. 33 $\frac{3}{4}$ E. 17.75 to a stone 3xnm on the White Horse Road; thence N. 71 E. 9.74 to a stone 3xnm on the right of way of the said railway, 50 feet from the centre of the track; thence along the right of way to the beginning point being the same conveyed to J.
