SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, *I*, the said *Virgil David Rosamond*,
in and by *2224* certain *Promissory note* in writing, of
even date with these presents, *assd*, well and truly indebted to
b.b. Gaad,

in the full and just of *Fifteen hundred and no 100 (\$1500.00)*
Dollars, to be paid *One year after date*,

with interest thereon, from *Date* at the rate of *eight* per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid *annually*,

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note..... to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof,
who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of *ten percent (10%)*
of the amount due thereon besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be
added to the amount due on said note....., to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or
any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note.....,
reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That *I*, the said *Mortgagor*,

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said *Mortgagor*,

according to the terms of the said note....., and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to *the said Mortgagor*,

in hand well and truly paid by the said *Mortgagor*,

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do

grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said *Mortgagor* and his heirs and assigns
forever, all and singular that certain pieces parcel lot or
tract of land situated lying and being in Greenville County,
State aforesaid. All that certain parcel or tract of land
situate lying and being in Greenville County, State of
South Carolina and being known and designated as tract
No. 1 as shown on plat of Warren Rosamond, property
made by R. E. Dalton April 3rd 1913, containing 53.80 acres
more or less and having the following metes and
bounds, to-wit: beginning at an iron pin corner of
tract No. one and No. Two and running thence N.
81-0 W. 1581 feet to an iron pin, thence S. 24-50 W.
1208.5 feet to a stone on Staunton Bridge Road
thence S. 46-0 E. along Staunton Bridge road 1346.7
feet to stone and iron pin, thence N. 34-0 E.
1231.6 feet to the beginning corner, bounded by tracts
of Henry Garrison, Allen Spence, Lathers and
Charles Rosamond Jr.
