SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I, the said B.M. Sloan

even date with these presents, an well and truly indebted to  
J.W. Norwood  
in the full and just of Four thousand (\$4,000.00)  
Dollars, to be paid \$2,000.00 to be paid on or before one year after date.  
\$2,000.00 to be paid on or before two years after date

with interest thereon, from date at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum to be  
computed and paid semi-annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note..... to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of  
ten per cent (10%) besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note....., to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note....., reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said J.W. Norwood, All that piece, parcel or lot of land in the

City of Greenville, State and County aforesaid, on the East side of Rowley Street, being known and designated as Lot #21 on plat of W.D. Neves dated April 1912, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin in the East side of Rowley Street 72 feet from corner of lot #5; thence S. 71-59 E. 192 feet 7 inches to iron pin; thence N. 20-10 E. 55 feet to iron pin; thence N. 71-59 W. 192 ft. 7 in. to iron pin on Rowley Street; thence with said Street S. 20-10 W. 55 feet to the beginning corner.

Being the same lot conveyed to me by J.W. Norwood by deed dated September 29, 1923, not yet recorded.

This mortgagor does give and deliver this instrument to the said J.W. Norwood to secure the balance of purchase price.
