SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, *I*, the said *J. Hudson Williams*  
in and by *my* certain *promissory* note in writing, of  
even date with these presents, *am* well and truly indebted to

*George Norwood*  
in the full and just sum of *Fifteen Hundred*  
Dollars, to be paid *on February 10, 1924*

with interest thereon, from *maturity* at the rate of *8* per cent. per annum, to be  
computed and paid *annually*

until paid in full, all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or  
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof,  
who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of *ten per cent.*  
besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be  
added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or  
any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note,  
reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the said *J. Hudson Williams*  
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof, to the said  
*George Norwood*  
according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to  
*J. Hudson Williams*, the said  
in hand well and truly paid by the said *George Norwood*

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do  
grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said *George Norwood*

All that lot of land situate in the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, having  
the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at an iron pin on College Street, corner  
of lot sold to George Norwood, and running thence along line of Norwood lot S. 20-54 W. 100  
feet to an iron pin; thence along line of Parrish and Gower S. 21-27 W. 45.1 feet to iron  
pipe on line of Earle property; thence along said line N. 67-45 W. 21.2 feet to iron pin;  
thence along line of Green property N. 48-40 E. 49.4 feet to iron pin; thence still with  
Green line N. 58-01 W. one (1) foot to point on line of Realty Development Company; thence  
along line of said Company N. 20-54 E. 100 feet to stake on south side of College Street;  
thence along the South side of College Street 58-01 E. 25 feet to the beginning.
