with interest thereon, from *Date given of this instrument* *18th Oct 33* at the rate of *8* per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid *on demand*.

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for attorney's fee of *1823*.

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said *J. D. Neal to his heirs and assigns*

all that piece parcel or lot of land in Greenville  
Parish, Greenville County, State of South Carolina  
in tract six of the City of Greenville on the east  
side of Hargeton Street and having the following  
metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at an iron  
pin on the corner of Hargeton Street and a ten  
foot alley, and running thence along Hargeton  
Street 72.2 E. 62.6 feet to the corner of lot no. 1, thence  
with line of lot no. 1 72.88 E. 174.5 feet to line of lot  
no. 4, thence with line of lot no. 4 2.2 E. 62.3 feet  
to an iron pin on a ten foot alley, thence with  
said alley S. 88 W. 178.1 feet to the beginning corner
