WHEREAS, *J.*, the said *Annie Ross*,  
in and by *my* certain *Promisee*,  
even date with these presents, *Green Bank & Trust Co.*  
in the full and just sum of *Three hundred*  
Dollars, to be paid *December 1st - 1924*.

with interest thereon, from *maturity April 1st 1924* at the rate of *8* per cent. per annum, to be  
computed and paid *annually*.

until paid in full, all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or  
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note, to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof,  
who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

*ten percent* *Green Bank & Trust Co.* besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be  
added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or  
any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note,  
reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do  
grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said *Green Bank and Trust Company*.

All of that certain piece, parcel or lot of land  
situate, lying and being in the State and County  
aforesaid, in Chick Springs Township on waters  
of Brushy Creek with the following metes and bounds,  
to wit:

Beginning at an iron pin in edge of old road,  
Beside Vaughan's corner and running due East  
14.75 chains to an iron pin on J. P. Ross' line,  
thence with said line S. 31-15 W. 22.51 chains to  
an iron pin on south bank of Brushy Creek 20 links  
from maple, corner of lot No. 3 and thence N. 38-15  
E. 4.17 chains to an iron pin in road; thence N. 2-15  
W. 6.81 chains to beginning corner containing sixteen  
and fifty-one hundredths acres (16.50) more or less  
according to plat of survey made by W. A. Christopher  
Oct. 12th - 1921 and known as lot No. 2 being a part  
of the tract conveyed to J. C. Ross by Richard Ross
