with interest thereon, from date at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum, to be
computed and paid usually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof,
who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten per cent.

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be
added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or
any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said U. D. L. Barksdale

All that certain piece, piece lot of land situate
lying and being in the County of Greenville and State aforesaid in
the City of Greenville, the South side of Stone
Avenue between the North side of Stone
and bounds as shown on the map of the ' Stone Avenue Map of the City of Greenville South Carolina dated May 15 1921 and recorded in the R. M. C. office of Greenville County in Deed Book 444 page 605

beginning at a stake on Stone Avenue 327 1/2 feet
westward from the northwest corner of Paines Street
and Stone Ave. and running thence N. 5 1/2 E. with
line of lot "C" 200 feet to stake, thence with line
of lot "B" N. 84 1/2 W. 65 feet to stake, thence with line
of lot "A" N. 5 1/2 W. 2 feet to Stone Ave. thence
with the north side of Stone Ave. S. 84 1/2 E. 65 1/2
feet to the beginning. Being the same lot of
land conveyed to me by Frank J. Dubrow, by deed
dated Mar. 15, 1921 and recorded in the R. M. C. office
