with interest thereon, from *date* at the rate of *8* per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid *as* *alleg*.

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of *ten per cent.*

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

All that piece, parcel or pieces of land situate, lying and being in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, within the incorporate limits of the City of Greenville, on the North side of Hamilton Avenue and being known as lot no. 16 on plat of property of Henry T. Mills, recorded in plat book "C" page 223 and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at a stake on the North side of Hamilton Avenue, at corner of lot no. 15, which point is 120 feet east from the intersection of Hamilton Avenue and Calhoun Street and running East with line of lot no. 15 N. 16-45 E. 175 feet to a stake on 15 foot alley thence along line of said alley S. 73-45 E. 60 feet to stake corner of lot no. 17; thence along line of lot no. 17 S. 16-45 N. 175 feet to a stake on Hamilton Avenue, thence N. 73-45 N. 60 feet to the beginning corner.
