SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, *I*, the said *Judson W. Chapman*, in and by *A* certain *Dec 22nd 1923* note in writing, of even date with these presents, *me*, well and truly indebted to,

Henry P. McGee
in the full and just sum of *One hundred + fifty* Dollars, to be paid *One year from date hereof*,

with interest thereon, from *March 15th, 1924* at the rate of *.8* per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid *Semi-annually*,

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of *Twenty-five Dollars* besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

Henry P. McGee according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to *me*, the said,

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said *Henry P. McGee His Heirs and Assigns* forever, ~~all~~ *that* piece parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the City of Greenville County and State aforesaid on East Avenue and known as Lot No. ~~20~~ ²⁰ according to Plat R. M. C. Greenville County South Carolina in Plat Book E at page 37 & 38 on South side of East Avenue and having a frontage of 64 feet and running back in parallel lines on West line 194 feet & on East side 190.5 feet being same lot conveyed to me by W. J. Langston.
