That I, Mary C. Calhoun of Greenville County, South Carolina, SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I, the said Mary C. Calhoun, in and by my certain Promissory note in writing, of even date with these presents, am well and truly indebted to

Mrs. J. W. Farrell, in the full and just sum of Two Thousand + ~~no~~ (\$2,000.00) Dollars, to be paid One (1) year after date

with interest thereon, from date at the rate of eight per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

Ten per cent (10%) besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said Mary C. Calhoun,

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said

Mrs. J. W. Farrell, according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said

Mary C. Calhoun, in hand well and truly paid by the said

Mrs. J. W. Farrell, at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Mrs. J. W. Farrell, her heirs and assigns + all that piece, parcel or lot of land situate in Greenville City, County and State aforesaid, on Ware Street, having a frontage on said Ware Street of about Fifty-Seven + one-half ($57\frac{1}{2}$) feet, with a depth of two hundred nine feet (209) and adjoining lots of Jas E. Payne, T. C. Lykes and others, and being the same lot conveyed to me by Thos. C. Lykes, by deed dated Feb. 12, 1906, and recorded in Volume R.R.R., Page 685, R.M.C. Office for Greenville County. +

Also, all that other piece, parcel or lot of land in the City of Greenville County and State aforesaid, described as follows:

Beginning on Barnwell Street at south east corner of Lot No. 16; thence with Lot No. 16, N. $18\frac{1}{2}$ E. 67 feet to corner of Lot No. 1; thence with Lot No. 1 S. $76\frac{2}{3}$ E. 75 feet; thence S. $18\frac{1}{2}$ W. 67 feet to Barnwell Street; thence with Barnwell Street N. $76\frac{2}{3}$ W. 75 feet to the beginning corner, and being the western half of Lot No. 2 according to plat recorded in Deed Book H.H.H., Page 842, and conveyed by Dan Richardson to me, and G. R. Calhoun, deed recorded in Volume 26, Page 547, R.M.C. Office for Greenville County.
