79 at page 191) said point being 244 feet from
the corner of Buncombe and Franklin Roads and
running thence with Franklin Road N. 32.35 E. 62 feet
to stake on side of said Road; thence parallel with
Buncombe Road S. 57.25 E. 200 feet to stake in line of lot
no. 7; thence along line of lot no. 7 and parallel
with Franklin Road S. 32.35 W. 62 feet to stake corner
