SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I, the said Mannie L. Phillips

with interest thereon, from date 10 at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum, to be
computed and paid monthly

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof,
who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten per cent. of the
amount due on said note besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be
added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or
any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note,

Lots Numbers 9, 37 and 38 of the Haynesworth Farm
lands, known as Arlington Heights, Lots 38 and 37
adjoin and front Perry Avenue one hundred feet, with
a depth of one hundred ninety one feet.
Lot number 9 fronts Sandelton Street about fifty-five
feet and has a depth of two hundred fourteen feet.
Said land containing my dwelling house thereon, and
is all of the land I conveyed to me by M. W. Campbell
