by deed from Lucius B. Perry, adjoining land of
myself and the Runnells Road:
beginning in center of Runnells Road thence
running N. 22° E. 104.3 feet to an iron pin; thence S.
65° E. 104.3 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 22° W. 104.3
feet to the center of said Road; thence with Road
N. 65° W. 104.3 feet to the beginning, and contains
