Also all my right, title and interest, same being an undivided one-half interest in that certain tract of land in the County and State aforesaid, on waters of Enoree River, containing 4 acres, more or less, being a part of the William T. Hill Home Place, bounded by lands now or formerly owned by Stephen Goldsmith and William T. Hill, and

Another tract of land in the County and State aforesaid, on waters of Enorse River, containing 40 acres, more or less, shown on plat made by J.B. Williams on Nov. 9, 1881; these two tracts of land being the same conveyed to Howard Caldwell and Jas. M. Richardson by J.A. Holcomb and being conveyed to J.A. Holcomb by J.W. Gray, Master, by deed dated Jan. 10, 1914, recorded in R.M.C. Office in Book 14, at page 170, reference to said deed being here made for a fuller and more definite description of said lands.
