SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, *E. Eddie M. Cox*, the said *Eddie M. Cox*,
in and by *himself* certain *Tradesmen*, note in writing, of
even date with these presents, *as above*, well and truly indebted to
The Peoples National Bank, Greenville, S.C.
in the full and just sum of *Twenty five \$25.00*
Dollars, to be paid *December 1st 1924*

with interest thereon, from *Maturity* at the rate of *8* per cent. per annum, to be
computed and paid *Annually*,

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note..... to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof,
who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of.....

.....besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be
added to the amount due on said note....., to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or
any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note.....,
reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That..... the said *Eddie M. Cox*,

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said *Eddie M. Cox*,

according to the terms of said note....., and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to *me*, the said

Eddie M. Cox,in hand well and truly paid by the said *Bard*,

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant,
bargain, sell and release unto the said *Bard*,

All that piece of land, being the remainder
of a tract of forty (40) acres, purchased by *E. Eddie M. Cox*,
to be sold by *Wm. H. Syde* by a deed dated January 1st,
1907, recorded in Vol. 11, p. 1, reference to
which is made for a more particular description.
The said *E. Eddie M. Cox* died intestate with the
land in his possession and left his sister, *Addie M. Cox*, as his sole heir at law. *Addie M. Cox* has
subsequently conveyed a tract of 30 acres unto *E. Eddie M. Cox* by her deed dated December 12th, 1923 and
recorded in Vol. 99 at page 165.
