WHEREAS, the said *M. A. Wallace*
 in and by 1914 certain *Charles L. Dugay* note in writing, of
 even date with these presents, well and truly indebted to
The Farmers Bank of Simpsonville
 in the full and just sum of *One hundred Fifty* (\$950.00)
 Dollars, to be paid *July 10, 1924*

with interest thereon, from *July 1st* at the rate of *Eight* per cent. per annum, to be
 computed and paid *July 1st* until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or

interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof,
 who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of *One-half cent*.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said *Farmers Bank of Simpsonville*

All that certain lot of land in the County and state aforesaid, in Butler Township, being Lot No. 5 in Block D of the subdivision known as "Carolina Court" in a plat recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, and having the following metes and bounds: Beginning at a point on the Eastern side of Montevista Ave. 268.3 feet from the Eastern corner of Montevista Ave. and Harrison Road, and running thence N. 21° 21' 18.8 feet 'more or less' to stake in line of original survey of boundary; thence N. 20.62 E. 65-feet along line of original boundary survey; thence N. 55.16 W. 185.3 feet to the Eastern line of Montevista Ave. thence along the Eastern line of Montevista Ave. 2.23.65 S. 1° 64.6 feet to the beginning corner being the same lot of land conveyed to me by C.
