AND LOAN ASSOCIATION all that ~~piece~~ ~~parcel~~ or lot of land lying in Greenville ~~South~~ Carolina near the Anderson Road, known as lot no. 19 on plat of lands of American Bank and Trust Company made by R. E. Allison, Engg. and recorded in Plat Book 3, page 44, having the following metes and bounds according to said plat: Beginning at an iron pin on the north east side of Garrison Street, corner of lot no. 20, (which pin is 107 feet S. 53-40 E. from Hill Street) and running thence with line of lot no. 20 N. 42-43 E., 200 feet to iron pin in line of lot no. 8; thence with line of lot 8 and lot 9, S. 53-40 E. 8-8- feet to iron pin, corner of lot 18; thence with line of said lot S. 42-43 E. 200 feet to iron pin on Garrison Street; thence with Garrison Street N. 53-40 E. 8-8- feet to the beginning corner.
