bargain, sell and release unto the said. Mrs. Memie H. Fulmer: All that certain piece, parcell or tracts of land lying and being and situate in the State and County aforesaid, on the new model is leading from Monaghan Cotton Mills to the White Horse Road, a few hundred yards South of Cumningham's Store, and containing 10.8 acres, more or less, and having the following thetes and bounds, to-wit;

Beginning at a stake on said road and running thence along same S. 26-15 E. 10.505te stake;

Beginning at a stake on said road and running thence along some S. 26-15 E. 10.50 to stake; thence S. 67-05 9.18 to stake on corner of lands now or formerly Berry's; thence N. 54 Hi 11.58 to the beginning corner on said road, less and excepting however, the tract of land containing five acres, heretofore conveyed by Mrs. Mamie H. Fulmer to H.L. Huff by deed dates Nec. 1922, recorded in R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Vol. 88, page 4, leaving 5.8 acres, more or less. Being the same tract of land conveyed to me by the said Mrs. Mamie H. Fulmer by deed of even date herewith the same not yet recorded, and this mortgage is given to require the credit portion of the purchase price therefor.

Also, all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate in Greenville mownship, Green wille County, State of South Carolina, near the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, known as Lot No. 146 on Plat of City View, made by W.A. Adams, Surveyor, recorded in R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "A", page 460, and described as follows according to said plat:

Beginning at an iron pin on a new cut road, at intersection of Hunt Street, and running thence along new cut road in an easterly direction 124 feet to corner of lot No. 147; thence in a westerly direction, along line of lot No. 147, 116 feet to Hunt Street; thence along Hunt Street in a Southernly direction 53 feet to the beginning.
