bargain, sell and release unto the said Thos. E. Roe:

All that certain piece, parcel or tract of
land, situate lying and being in Bates
Township, County and state aforesaid, and
having the following metes and bounds,
to-wit: Beginning at a stone, 0m, corner of
W. L. Green and J. W. Sprouse's land and
running thence N. $7\frac{1}{2}$ E. 10.07 to the center of
the tigerville Road; thence with said road,
N. 81 E. 4.36; thence S. 11 C. 8.92 to an iron pin 0m;
thence S. 68 W. 5.10 to the beginning corner,
containing four and two fifths ($4\frac{2}{5}$) acres
more or less, according to a plat made by
W. A. Hester, Surveyor, dated August 13th, 1924,
bounded by lands of H. E. Hart, W. L. Green, J. W.
