in the full and just sum of Four Thousand Four Hundred + no/100 (\$4,400.00)
Dollars, to be paid Sixty + no/100 (\$600.00) Dollars on September 1st
1924 and Sixty (\$600.00) Dollars per month, payable
on the first day of each succeeding month here-
after, until paid in full, with the privilege of anticipating
the whole amount at any time at the rate of eight per cent. per annum, to be
computed and paid semi-monthly

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof,
