 with interest thereon from date  
 computed and paid annually  
 until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or  
 interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof,  
 who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of  
*ten per cent.* besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same to be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or of said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate lying and being in the state of South Carolina County of Greenville, in Greenville Township, in the 6th Ward of the city of Greenville, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on Greene Avenue at the corner of A. W. Hill's lot and running thence with Greene Avenue, S. 29° W. 79 $\frac{1}{2}$  feet to an iron pin, corner of Emmett's lot; thence with Emmett's line S. 61° E. 151 feet to an iron pin; thence along line of M. B. Leach and Mrs. Hattie McGehee N. 29° E. 69 $\frac{1}{2}$  feet to an iron pin, corner of A. W. Hill's lot; thence with A. H.
