with interest thereon, from date at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum, to be
computed and paid annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof,
who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

ten per cent besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be
added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same to be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or of said debt, or
any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note
reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said Emanuel Morris
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said

according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said
Emanuel Morris
in hand well and truly paid by the said U. P. Hudson

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents, do grant,
bargain, sell and release unto the said U. P. Hudson:

All that certain piece, parcel or tract of
land, situate, lying and being in the
state and county aforesaid, in Butler
Township, being known as lots Nos. 3 and
4 of the L. B. Smith Place, containing 47 acres
more or less, adjoining lands of Mrs. C. Smith
Mrs. W. Green, Sloane Stroud, et al, and being
the same land conveyed to me by C. Irmate
Master for Greenville County, by his deed
dated 11th day of December 1905, recorded
in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County
in Vol. 14 of Deeds, at page 447.

Also all that certain piece, parcel or tract
of land with all the improvements thereon
situate, lying and being in the state
County and Township aforesaid, about nine
miles from Greenville Court House
near the Pelham Road, containing
40 acres more or less, adjoining lands
of Cannilla Smith, S. L. Stroud and
Others, and being the same land
