Davis and Grant Wilbanks, thence in a southerly direction in a line parallel with Ware Street fifty feet and 45/100 feet to an iron pin thence in a westerly direction with line of lot of Mary Calhoun ninety-nine and 49/100 feet to a iron pin on Ware Street, and thence with Ware Street in a northwesterly direction fifty-four and 45/100 feet to the beginning corner.
