County, South Carolina, about four miles from Greenville
Court House, South Carolina, in a road and being a
portion of tract No. 1 of the Warren Roseland property,
described in the Will of Warren Roseland, on file
in the Probate Office for Greenville County, wherein
he devised the same to his son Charlie M. Roseland,
leaving according to a plat made by W. H. Millard,
Engineer, Nov. 1924 the following 'metes and bounds'
to wit: Beginning at an iron pin corner of Satterfield
property, and running thence S. 25° 30' W. 1033.5 feet to
Stone, corner of Allen Yancey's property, thence along line
