WHEREAS, I, the said Emmett Emory, in and by myself certain Promissory Note even date with these presents, and J. W. Griffith, well and truly indebted to Emmett Emory in the full and just sum of Eight thousand (\$8000.00) Dollars, to be paid one year from the date hereof.

with interest thereon, from the date at the rate of 7 per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid.

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

ten percent besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as part thereof, if the same to be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or of said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, J. W. Griffith, in consideration of the said debt and full and the lien of my money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said,

according to the terms of said note, and two in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, (\$3.00), the said,

in hand, well and truly paid by the said Emmett Emory,

at and before the signing WITNESSES present whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said J. W. Griffith and his heirs and assigns,

the following described real Estate First: all that certain piece, parcels or tract of land situated lying and being in the state and County aforesaid in Chicopee Township on the White Springs Road, about three miles south of Greenville, bounded and having the following named lands bounded to the north by White Springs Road (beginning at an iron post in the center of the White Springs Road at Douglas Corner) and running thence with said White Springs Road S. 37-30 W. 33-3 feet wide to an iron post (iron corner); thence with Douglas line N. 80-30 W. 67-3 feet to an iron post (Douglas corner); thence with Douglas southern line S. 80-30 W. 67-1 feet to the beginning corner and containing 10 39/100 acres, more or less. Second: all that certain piece parcel or tract of land situated lying and being in the County and state aforesaid in Chicopee Township on the south side of White Springs Road and having the following corners and boundaries to wit: Beginning at an iron post in White Springs Road, corner of G. J. Douglas and J. W. Griffith lands, and runs thence with said line S. 78-45 E. 292 feet to intersection of new line; thence with new line S. 78-45 N. 367 feet to a new corner in center of White Springs Road; thence with said White Springs Road S. 38 W. 36 feet to the beginning corner and contains 16/100 of an acre, more or less, it soon being the case that two tracts of land, conveged to make the said Emmett Emory up J. W. Griffith by his deed bearing even date with these presents and hereafter to be recorded. This mortgage is given to secure the balance of the purchase money for the lands hereinabove described.
