SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I, the said P. S. Hawkins, in and by a certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these presents, 1921, well and truly indebted to

Taylor's Lumber Company, (Taylor's, S.C.) in the full and just sum of One Thousand and Six Hundred Thirty-five + 69/100 Dollars, to be paid One year from date hereof,

with interest thereon, from date full until paid at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid monthly, until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note, to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fees of \$100.00 per suit.

Paid day of August 1926 besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, the same to be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or of said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

all these four lots or parcels of land at Taylor's Lumber Company, having known and designated as the numbers 18, 19, 20 and 21 of the subdivision of the P. W. Hackley property.
