That certain lot or parcel of land situate in the State of South Carolina, Greenville County, known as Tract #83, on Plat 2 of the Parker Land Co., surveyed by A.S. Bedell, April 1924, and more particularly bounded and described as follows:

Beginning on a stone below a wild cherry tree, the northwest corner of tract #79, runs thence with the line of tract #79, W. 81 degrees East 10.45 chains to the northeast corner of tract #79, in the center of Parker Road.
